Old (Levi Ames Son in law) in 1870. Truck farming post civil war (carbays, potatoes, as park gus, melons, greens, etc.) Form taken over by W. N. Old Tr about 1900 + he farmed until 1953. Saybeam, Peanuts, com, & wheat. Later cotton. R. Old grun famed 1953 - 1965. House built by John Arnes. Simple half Tederal home. " Middle class" formhome that is remarkably intact.
